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Lucell A. Larawanhas been a recognized culture advocate and visual artist. He maintains a regular column in The Daily Guardian (region 6 second leading newspaper) where he also writes about art criticism. He bagged two finalist awards in national Metrobank (one of the most prestigious art contests in the Philippines) sculpture, has had held four solo exhibits, worked as a cultural worker, and became a general member of the National Commission for Culture and the Arts-National Committee on Visual Arts. He founded and led Hebron Artists which produced a national champion in sculpture and a multi-awardee currency and medal designer of Central Bank. He also significantly pushed the Center of Excellence status of his previous college having provided 80 percent of its scientific paper publications. Where locals are least expected, Larawan established intellectual leadership in editorial boards of international peer-reviewed journals: He is the only Filipino who serves in the editorial teams of two business journals published by the American Research Institute for Policy Development. Larawan does not see the need to earn the less-credible doctorate programs around; but he received a Ph.D. in Social Sciences and Fine Arts (honoris-causa) after carving a track record in these disciplines.
