COURSES COMPLETED AT PRATT INSTITUTE:

PRINTMAKING - Etching, Aqua tint, dry point, linoleum prints, spitbite aquatint, engraving, inking copper plates and creating a large set of prints at the end of the course.

ARTIST AS CURATOR - Analysis of art and how it can be approached as a curator, how to evaluate space, research on ideas for shows, present professional proposals for shows in NY, budgeting the event (including all licenses and permits that would be necessary for it), travelling to artist's studios in order to see and evaluate their work, learning how to curate a Biennial, understanding the legal implications of being a curator and drawing up a contract, working with non-profit organizations and museums.

INSTALLATION - Planning and drawing perspective sketches of the space that is alotted, painting the space to suit the idea and therefore using it to install it, use of mixed media and construction material to fulfil the final result.
