In 2003 she captured the realistic painting



of artist Baudilio Rodriguez force and decided to experiment with realism and other styles, but since 2007 and without leaving to one side the realism, will investigate in abstract painting where the aluminum has been the most experienced of the stands because it allows you to create drawings with own light through wear on the metal (drawing by light reflection) After combining with industrial paints and other materials such as animal hairs, plushes, tackle with paints, resins, etc. In 2016 creates the Group tackle-given with proposals of research in art urban local. He has been doing a series of sculptures in aluminium, where the concept is the abstraction of the lightness and light in volume. In short, his career as an experimental artist has served to be an artist with a diversity of sources and Visual, between realism and abstraction combining expressions.
